- 4) Permanent Lot Maintenance** - If you have a permanent lot, it is your job to keep it clean and tidy.

- 6) Golf Cart Registration** - Please remember to register your golf cart when you arrive. Registration is \$20.
- 7) Parking** - If you are staying at camp, we ask you to park in the west field. This leaves more space up front for those commuting in for service.
